### Summary of Events

#### Burglary of Habitation -

16400 Fox Crossing Ln - Suspect(s) forced entry into the complainant's residence without permission shortly after resident left to go out of town. Complainant was unsure if the suspect stole any property.

7700 Theissetta Dr – Suspect(s) forced entry into complainant's residence without permission and stole property. Suspect(s) fled the scene undetected.

#### Burglary of a Motor Vehicle -

8100 Cypresswood Dr - Complainant reported that a suspect made unlawful entry into her vehicle without her permission and stole property.

7400 Louetta Rd - Complainant reported a suspect forced entry into her vehicle while parked at a local business. Complainant reported several items were stolen.

#### Theft - Other

16600 Fern Rock Falls Ct – Complainant reported that when he attempted to file his taxes he discovered that a unknown suspect filed a income tax return using his identity.

8200 Louetta Rd – Complainant reported that a suspect entered his business, received service and would not pay. Deputy completed investigation, and charges were filed against the suspect who was later arrested.

7700 Louetta Rd – Complainant reported that his cell phone was stolen while he was at work. Complainant had no suspect information, nor a time the theft occurred.

#### Criminal Mischief -
