Summary of Events

Burglary Habitation

16000 Kleinwood Dr. – Complainant stated unknown suspect(s) broke into the vacant home and caused damage to the carpets and to two window screens.

Burglary Vehicle

Criminal Mischief

7400 Louetta Rd – During day time hours the complainant's driver side window was smashed and broken while at the L.A. Fitness.

7300 Louetta Rd. – During day hours complainant stated 5 to 6 unknown suspects attempted to break in the business at HEB. Males can be seen on camera attempting to use crowbars to open the sliding doors. All suspects fled the scene without making entry and caused damage to the door.
