

1. Consider comments and questions from District residents (3-minute limit);

  - (a) consider tax rate recommendation from the District's Financial Advisor;
  - (b) schedule public hearing on proposed 2024 tax rate and authorize publication of notice of hearing;
  - (c) status of continuing disclosure filing for the District (due 9/30/24);
5. Report on maintenance of stormwater detention facilities;
6. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
  - (a) authorize payments from the District's Tax Account;
  - (b) status report regarding delinquent tax accounts;

  - (a) status of Lift Station No. 3 improvements (AR Turnkey Construction Co.);
